



Choo Siew Cheong, or better known as Moses among the blindness community was born visually impaired. By the age of eight, he was already an orphan and spent ten years of his youth at the St. Nicholas School for the blind, Penang, where he feels rather indebted to the staff and management of the school.

With his plans of becoming a professional shattered after receiving his rejection by the Australian High Commission in 1977, he started his career as a book shop Assistant with the in-house book shop of Taylor's College. After more than 25 years in a corporate environment, he had had the opportunity of holding positions such as a switchboard operator, Technology support, Purchasing Assistant and an Admin Manager.

Prior to joining the National Council for the Blind, he was the Admin Manager for Total Corporate Compliance Sdn Bhd, presently known as the Tricor group of companies. In 2002, he joined the National Council for the Blind, Malaysia as an Executive Officer of the Blind Professional Assistance Unit. Within four years, he assumed the post of Assistant Executive Director. In January of 2014, he was appointed the Executive Director.

Moses may be vision impaired but he has vast experience in the use of products related to Information Communications and Technology. He hopes to be able to bring in solutions to help solve the barriers faced by the blind people of Malaysia.
